**Issue of €600,000,000 4.157 per cent. Senior Notes due 2028 (the “Notes”)**

**Debt Issuance Programme**

This document constitutes the Final Terms relating to the issue of Notes described herein. Terms used herein shall be deemed to be defined as such for the purposes of the Conditions incorporated by reference in the drawdown prospectus dated 15 February 2023 (the “Drawdown Prospectus”) relating to the Notes. These Final Terms contain the final terms of the Notes and must be read in conjunction with the Drawdown Prospectus and the information incorporated by reference therein. Terms defined in the Base Prospectus have the same meaning when used herein.

In connection with this issue, Mizuho International plc (the “Stabilising Manager”) or any person acting for the Stabilising Manager may over-allot or effect transactions with a view to supporting the market price of the Notes at a level higher than that which might otherwise prevail for a limited period. However, there may be no obligation on the Stabilising Manager or any agent of the Stabilising Manager to do this. Such stabilising, if commenced, may be discontinued at any time and must be brought to an end after a limited time.
